The business meeting was opened with prayer and the lighting of the Christ candle, by Moderator Ann Hunter. The **minutes** of the Fall Gathering, Oct. 20, 2008, were approved as read.

Joan and Myra said that a silver PW pin is now available which commemorates the 20th anniversary of the organization. Joan and Ann encouraged us to plan and save to attend the Churchwide Gathering in 2009.

Ann asked us to start the process to identify the woman who can become Vice Moderator and attend the Churchwide Gathering with Myra, as a voting delegate. Ann said it is an incredible experience.
